SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS:

- 1) The Austin Ten Drivers Club, on behalf of the Inter Register Club, will organise a Gymkhana on Saturday 12th October 2019 in the car park of The Frinton on Sea Cricket Club, Ashlyn's Road, Frinton-on-Sea, Essex, CO13 9EU. Ordnance Survey map reference 201229 from Map 196 (Ipswich and The Naze, Clacton on Sea).
- 2) The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the RAC Motor Sports Association Ltd, these supplementary regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.
- 3) The RAC Motor Sports Association will issue an exemption certificate for this event.
- 4) The event is open to all fully elected members of any club associated to the Inter Register Club (IRC).
- 5) Competitors and drivers may be asked to produce a valid Club membership card (or other evidence of being a member of an associate club).
- 6) The event is a round of the Inter Register Club Championship.
- 7) The programme of the meeting will be; Signing on from 10.00am. Any competitor not signed on by 11.00 may be excluded. Tests will start at 10.45 and will end no later than 5.00pm.
- 8) Cars will be required to complete a number of Tests of driving skill and competence. All tests will be carried out entirely on private land on grass. The Schedule of Tests will be supplied after signing in.
- 9) The event will consist of two classes; **Experts** and **Novices**. (*A novice is one who has not been placed in the first three classes in any VSCC Autotest or gained 1st, 2nd, or 3rd in any Inter Register Autotest.*) Competitors are to declare their status on the Entry form.
- 10) Awards will be presented for First, Second, Third individual places, best team and best placed novice.
- 11) The entry fee for the competition is £10. All entries must be on the official entry form accompanied by the fee. Entries close on 5th October 2019.
- 12) The Secretary of the meeting to whom all entries must be sent is; Geoffrey Pickard, 18, Alfred Terrace, Walton on the Naze, Essex, CO14 8PD.
- 13) Minimum entry for the meeting is 12 & maximum 40. If the minimum figure is not reached the organisers may cancel the meeting. Entries will be accepted in the order of receipt of the entry form.
- 14) Marking and penalties will be set out in the Schedule of Tests and provisional results will be published as soon as possible after the end of the event.
- 15) It is intended that there will be a break between the morning and afternoon tests. Food and refreshments will be available at the Clubhouse. Please indicate on the entry form how many will require food.
