



MG Car Club Ltd Club Much Marcle Navigation Scatter Sat 14th June 2025

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. The **MG Car Club Ltd Midland Centre** will organise a Navigational Scatter Rally on Saturday 14th June 2025. The event will be held under the National Competition Rules of Motor Sport UK Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any Instructions issued for the event.
Motorsport UK Ltd Certificate of Exemption Permit has been applied for.
2. The event is open to members of **MG Car Club**, **VSCC** and **HRCR** in any age of car and the **Inter-Register Club** in pre 1960 vehicles, as a round of the Inter-Register Club Championship.
All competitors (driver and all passengers) must hold a Motorsport UK RS Clubman Licence which is free and can be applied for on-line if you hold a UK Passport at <https://rsclubman.motorsportuk.org/>.
Club Membership Cards and Licences may be inspected at Signing-on.
3. The event will be run using the 1:50,000 series Ordnance Survey map, Landranger 149, Hereford & Leominster.
Equipment Required: A recent paper version of this map, pen or pencil for marking points on the map and filling in answers to the clue-point questions. A Romer, for plotting grid references onto the map, or a metric ruler can be used. Protractor might be useful.
Satnavs or Global Positioning Systems are not allowed. The penalty for their use is disqualification.
4. The event will start and finish at Westons Cider Mill, at Map Ref:149 / 649330 Arrivals between 09.45hrs and 10.15hrs and any competitor not parked up by 10.30hrs may be deemed a non-starter. Route cards will be issued at minute intervals from 10.30hrs. Cars will then leave in their own time and return to finish from 14.30hrs (4 hours total time). Entrants in Pre-1960 cars will have an additional 15 minutes penalty free lateness (4 hrs 15 mins total time).
5. Trailers and support vehicles can be left at this venue during the event at the owner's risk.
6. Navigators must plot the location of each cluepoint using a variety of navigation techniques which give a theoretical route from the start venue to the cluepoint. Do NOT attempt to drive these routes to reach the cluepoint but, after plotting them all, or as many cluepoints as you can, create your own circular route to reach those that you wish to visit.

7. Entrants will be required to visit a selection of locations in any order, and at each clue-point will need to answer a related question. Entrants will NOT be required to visit all 20 locations, and a maximum number of answers to count towards the final score will be the first 15 completed on the answer sheet.
Entrants are likely to cover up to 60 miles, depending on their chosen route. In some instances, it will be necessary to alight from the car to find the answer.
8. The event is untimed other than having an overall time period for completion. Competitors must at all times comply with Road Traffic Acts and the Highway Code whilst driving on the public highway and reckless speed or driving will be penalised.
9. Drivers must ensure that their vehicle insurance will cover use on this event as technically it is classified as a Rally Event by Motorsport UK, albeit with no Time Controls.
10. As there will be no scrutineering, every driver must sign the organisers' document confirming that his vehicle is in good working order and safe to use on the public highway. The event Clerk of the Course has authority to decline a start if he deems the condition of any competing vehicle to be unsatisfactory – his decision is final and not subject to protest.
11. Classes will be as follows:

Class A	Pre 1960 Vehicle Expert
Class B	Pre 1960 Vehicle Novice
Class C	Post 1960 Expert
Class D	Post 1960 Novice

A Novice crew is one in which no member has won a 1st, 2nd or 3rd Class award in any navigational event during the previous three years.

The organisers reserve the right to amalgamate classes if necessary.

Novices on their first navigation event can copy some clue-points from the organiser's master map and will then be eligible only for their class award, with a deduction of 4 points from their finishing total.

No penalty will be incurred for carrying additional passengers, but driver and navigator must be nominated on the Entry Form and all occupants must hold a Motorsport UK RS Clubman Licence.

12. Marking. There will be 20 clue-point locations to plot, and, on visiting up to 15 of them, a question to be answered on the Score Sheet provided. Each Cluepoint will carry a score of 4 points, regardless of location or difficulty. At five Cluepoints there will be an additional Bonus Question carrying a further 4 points. However, you must visit no more than THREE of these Bonus Clue-points. In addition, you MUST find at least THREE of the five Codeboard Cluepoints.

From the time of issue of your Route Card, you will have 4 hrs to return with your completed Score Sheet, plus a further 15 minutes for entrants in pre 1960 cars. Lateness will be penalised at a rate of 4 marks for every five minutes or part thereof up to a maximum lateness of 20 minutes which will be deemed as Retirement. (i.e. 1 to 4 mins – 4 marks lost; 5 to 9 mins. – 8 marks lost, etc)
There will be a Tie-break Question relating to one particular Cluepoint.

13. Awards will be as follows :-
 1. First in class (subject to 3 entries in class).
 2. Best performance by a MGCC MemberEntrants can win only one of the above awards.

The maximum number of entrants is 20 and the minimum is 8.
Please try to ensure the success of the event by booking well in advance.
The Entry List opens on publication of these Regulations and closes on Monday 9th June 2025 at mid-day.

18. Petrol can be obtained on the A40 at Ross-on-Wye, 7 miles south of the venue.
